Northampton Primary Academy Trust Education, Standards and Performance Committee Terms of Reference 2023-24



Overview

• The committee is responsible for the strategy, planning and monitoring of matters relating to educational standards and teaching and learning matters across the Trust.

Membership

- The committee members shall consist of three Trustees and up to two co-opted members from within the Trust. All of whom shall have voting rights. On occasions, other members of the Trust's education team may attend to input on specific agenda items.
- The quorum shall be three members, two of whom must be Trustees. The meeting cannot take place unless quorum is reached.
- The meeting will be chaired by a Trustee elected by the Board of Trustees.

Meetings

- The committee shall meet three times a year to and otherwise as required. Meetings shall be scheduled in October, January and May.
- Minutes of committee meetings will be agreed by the committee members prior to circulation by the Clerk to the Board of Trustees.

Committee Responsibilities

- 1. Monitor that the highest possible standards are set and maintained for education across the Trust
- 2. Receive a termly report from the School Improvement Team regarding standards and performance of the Trust against key performance indicators
- 3. Identify any areas of concern in respect of standards and performance and to agree/monitor subsequent action plans with the Executive Team
- 4. Oversee the implementation of a broad, rich and rigorous curriculum, ensuring that all children in the Trust receive this entitlement
- 5. Scrutinise and review relevant educational Trust policies for recommendation to the Trust Board
- 6. Ensure that effective processes are in place for the quality assurance of teaching and learning, the curriculum, inclusion and the sharing of good practice across the Trust

- 7. Support the Chief Executive Officer in the creation, implementation and monitoring of the Trust's improvement plan
- 8. Advise the Trust Board regarding targets for pupil achievement across the Trust
- 9. Monitor the effectiveness of the Trust's policies and procedures for safeguarding, pastoral care, pupil attendance and behaviour
- 10. Review on a regular basis, its own performance, constitution and terms of reference to ensure it is operating at maximum effectiveness.
